XII. Fire Department (David Harris, Ladder 2):

- 1. Be careful of electrical violations. Do not plug two extension cords together.
- 2. Take care of electrical cords. It they are frayed, replace them.
- 3. If your smoke alarm is over 10 years old, replace it.

 Change the battery twice a year, in Spring and Fall, at Daylight Savings Time.
- 4. Place smoke detectors outside sleeping areas... do not put carbon monoxide (CO2) detector in the basement.
- 5. Vacuum your detectors to remove dust. Be sure they are working properly after you finish cleaning them.
- 6. Enroll in Smart 911. It will increase the ability of the paramedics to care for you.
